1. Prosecco Canal Grando Extra Dry - Veneto, Italy	£7.50	£32
A gentle mousse, crisp and refreshing, this delicate Prosecco has a rounded palate and an irresistibly fruity finish. (Ve)		
2. Prosecco Brut Terre di Sant'Alberto Rosé - D.O.C. Italy		£35
Light pink in colour and crafted from 85% Glera and 15% Pinot Noir to produce a delightfully fresh and fruity prosecco that fills the glass with red summer berries and white flowers. (Ve)		
3. Baron Albert L'Universelle Brut - Champagne, France	£12	£65
A family-owned Champagne house ran by three sisters. Contains a large percentage of Pinot Meunier giving an approachable wine with strawberry leaf and citrus aromas. (Ve)		
4. Joseph Perrier 'Cuvée Royale' Brut - Champagne, France		£80
A remarkable and noble Champagne house still under family ownership. Fresh fruity aromas such as pear and red apple lead to richer fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit. (Ve)		
5. Joseph Perrier Blanc de Blancs NV - Champagne, France		£90
Elegant and complex with aromas of white flowers, apricot and Mirabelle plums. The palate has plenty of fresh citrus notes and lively acidity, some touches of spice and vanilla, rich brioche elements and a long lemony finish. (Ve)		
6. Bollinger Special Cuvée - Champagne, France		£95
The purist expression of Bollinger's house style, this has a biscuity nose and a rich yet balanced palate.		
7. Bollinger Rosé - Champagne, France		£100
A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity, with a slightly tannic finish due to the addition		

of red wine; flavours of wild berries and bubbles like velvet

15. Grüner Veltliner, 'Is This It?', Collection Dunavar - Hungary			£29
Zesty example of the grape grown in the ancient winemaking regions of Hungary. Classic whin notes with crunchy green apple and celery.	te pepper		
16. Vinho Verde, Ponte de Lima - Vinho Verde, Portugal			£30
The wine that has lifted spritz for which it is famous. A crisp palate with notes of melon, citrus and green apple. $(V)$			
17. Garganega, Cantina Negrar - Veneto, Italy			£31
Superbly dry and crisp, a straw yellow classic Italian white wine with delicate notes of white fr Slightly floral, and medium bodied with a finish of bitter almonds, typical of the Garganega v			
18. Sauvignon Blanc Faultline, Marlborough - South Island, New Zealand			£31

A stunning Marlborough for the price. It shows grassy notes, peapods, gooseberry and asparagus with a fresh and herbaceous flavour and a subtly tropical finish on the palate.

19. Muscadet de Sevre et Maine sur lie, 'La Sablette' - Loire, France	£31
A delicate white wine crafted to pair with seafood. Fresh and dry in style it has clean, refreshing acidity. The name 'La Sablette' refers to the claws of a Lobster, as depicted on the bottle.	
20. Grenache Blanc, Heilan Coo - Victoria, South Africa	£32
A rare Grenache from Victoria, named after the Scottish Highland cows that graze around the family winery. A ripe mouth watering white with spicy aromas, and gently floral. Notes of apricot and peach lead to a generous palate with crisp salinity on the finish.	
21. Gavi - San Silvestro, Italy	£34
This crisp white wine shows incredible mineral, zesty citrus and floral notes, with a hint of spice. Prominent mineral characters linger on the deliciously mouthwatering finish. (Ve)	
22. Sauvignon Blanc, Delheim - Stellenbosch, South Africa	£35
This light-toned wine has an expressive nose of citrus, passion fruit and lime zest notes. The palate is soft with a good balance between the vibrant fruit flavours and acidity that leaves you salivating. (Ve)	
23. Torrontes, Andeluna 1300 - Uco Valley	£36
Made from premium grapes grown at an altitude of 1300 metres, in the foothills of the Andes. This is one of the most complex wines you can buy at the price: wonderfully aromatic and grapey, with a mixture of crisp mineral and tropial flavours. (Ve)	
24. Chenin Blanc wild ferment, Delheim - Stellenbosch, South Africa	£36
Dominant fragrances on stone fruits and orange peel held together by a subtle hint of caramel.Vibrant pear and green apple notes, a plentiful mouthful and lasting finish are in beautiful harmony on the palate.	
25. Coteaux du Giennois Blanc, Domaine Berthier - Loire, France	£39
Since 2015, Clement and Florian have been developing in the north of the Coteaux du Giennois appellation, in the village of Beaulieu-sur-Loire. A light, dry Sauvignon Blanc from Loire at a good price. Carved herbs, citrus, grapefruit, and a bit of white fruit lend to good acidity.	
26. Albariño, Lenda - Rías Baixas, Spain	£40
Beautiful floral and herbal notes are combined with an elegant minerality as well as citrus and white fruit. Medium-bodied ripe fruit precedes a long and pleasant finish.	
27. Riesling, Pewsey Vale - Eden Valley, Australia	£43
Delicacy, finesse and intense lemon and lime characters are the hallmarks of this well-balanced wine.	

Dry and mineral with a pleasing oily texture that coats the tongue, this is a great Riesling. (Ve)

28. Chardonnay Reserve, Vergelegen - Somerset West, South Africa	£45
An attractive lemony yellow-green colour with a complex nose of citrus and orange blossom, white peach, pineapple, apricot and hints of hot buttered toast. The taste is long and elegant with a lively minerality. (Ve)	
29. Petit Chablis, Domaine Ellevin - Burgundy, France	£48
Soft orchard fruits greet the nose leading to a palate that is generous for a Chablis. Floral hints and chalky minerality complete the finish.	
30. Mâcon La Roche-Vineuse, Domaine Normand - Burgundy, France	£49
Beautiful looking with a bright, young, pale yellow colour. Intense, attractive and rich on the nose, with hints of very ripe white and yellow fruit and exotic fruit aromas. A fruity wine which is big, smooth, and fresh on the palate.	
31. Chardonnay 'Filius', Vasse Felix - Margaret River, Australia	£51
Vasse Felix are producing some of the best Chardonnay in Australia right now. The wine is identified by its bright, elegant fruit, subtle wild complexities and a light acid structure, reflecting the vibrancy and purity of this variety in Margaret River.	
32. Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine des Berthiers, Jean-Claude Dagueneau - Loire, France	£56
Refined & classy Sauvignon, with a lively palate redolent with herbaceous notes. A signature flinty minerality and a dry, elegant finish.	
33. Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Berthier - Loire, France	£59
Made from vineyards with half flint and half clay giving a rounded blend of the two. A focused Sauvignon Blanc wine with mineral and citrus notes and a long finish.	
34. Rully Blanc 1er Cru 'Meix Cadot' Domaine Rolland Sounit, Burgundy, France	£66
Flinty, smoky notes of concentration fill the nose on this wine. The palate offers freshness but also a slightly synthetic tone. The body is balanced, and the wine is slender and refreshing.	
35. Pouilly Fuisse 1er Cru 'Au Vignerais', Domaine Normand, Burgundy, France	£75

A fine nose with white and citrus fruits, flowers and fresh butter with clear and precise aromas. Well blended woody notes support this structured, rich and fat wine with a mineral and citrus finish.

Intense aromas of blackcurrants and wild fruits are complemented by subtle notes of spice and thyme in this full-bodied Negroamaro. Charmingly balanced and juicy on the palate, this is full of the flavours of Southern Italy. (Ve)			
45. Cabernet Sauvignon, Baron d'Arignac - Pays D'Oc, France			£26
Bursting with summer fruits followed by a soft and spicy finish. Medium-bodied Cabernet with good varietal character.			
46. Primitivo, Il Pumo, Salento - San Marzano, Italy			£29
An intense aroma of plum, cherry and spice, with hints of rosemary and vanilla. A full-bodied wine, soft and balanced, full of ripe fruit flavours in an easy drinking style. (Ve)			
47. Nero d'Avola, Boccantino - Puglia, Italy			£30
Intense violet, spices and red fruit. Full-bodied but smooth with a smooth, spicy finish on the p	palate.		
48. Malbec, Lorca Lorca - Uco Valley, Argentina			£31
Fresh blueberry and berries with a savoury hint of leather and toast. Very fresh on the finish

49. Old Vines Garnacha Tintorera, Piqueras - Almansa, Spain	£32
Rich and full-bodied red wine deep in colour with an extensice range of ripe dark fruit, wild strawberry and fresh herbs. Smooth juicy tannins and good freshness combine to offer a wine full of flavour and enjoyment. (Ve)	
50. Shiraz Mataro, Heilan Coo - Victoria, Australia	£36
Celebrating the iconic Highland cow which admire Australia as here for their gentle nature and high quality beef. A well-bred wine dripping with plum and chocolate flavours. The Mataro adds a depth and subtle spice notes.	
51. Pinot Noir, Odd Lot - California, USA	£36
A charming, ripe style of the grape, singing with cherry and raspberry fruits. A rich palate with notes of berry fruit, cedar and toast before a focussed fresh finish.	
52. Zweigelt, Tattendorf - Thermenregion, Austria	£37
A crunchy red with great freshness alongside the red and black berry fruit. Good complexity and length with notes of cedar, pine and black forest gateau. (Ve)	
53. Rioja Reserva - Hugonell, Spain	£43
A complex, Concentrated Rioja, only made in exceptional years. Aged for at least 3 years before release, with at least a year in oak barrels, it shows spicy red fruit flavours, with juicy ripeness and hints of cedar and coffee beans. On the palate, this is a silky, elegant wine with a long finish. (Ve)	
54. Bourgogne Rouge, Domaine du Beauregard - Burgundy, France	£47
Well made and ambitious wine showing a great complexity of black cherry, currants and pencil shavings. Ample and structured in the mouth with all the charm of Burgundy you might expect.	
55. Syrah 'The Pack', Painted Wolf - Swartland, South Africa	£48
Made from organically grown grapes in a single vineyard. A rich harmonious medium to full bodied wine with juicy dark berry fruit, savoury smoked ham, all spice and aromatic wood aromas. The wine has a mid-palate coating with ripe tannins and a long finish. (Ve)	
56. Pinotage, 'Guillermo', Painted Wolf - Swartland, South Africa	£49
An intense, rich wine packed with flavours of ripe blueberry and mulberry, exotic spice and creamy vanilla, with evident ripe tannins and a long lingering finish. (Ve)	
57. Fleurie, Maison Dominique Piron - Beaujolais, France	£50
A luscious, fruit-filled, seductively silky Bequiolais Cru from Piron's 14th generation estate. This is top vintage	

A luscious, fruit-filled, seductively silky Beaujolais Cru from Piron's 14th generation estate. This is top vintage Fleurie, great quality but low quantity due to hail and frost. Relish the plush, rounded cherry and blackberry fruit.

58. Château Cissac - Haut-Médoc, France	£51
Cissac is well known for producing great wines year in year out. A large proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon gives the wine great backbone and flavours of blackcurrant and tobacco.	
59. Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore 'San Rocco', Tedeschi - Veneto, Italy	£53
Made using the ancient wine making technique 'ripasso' where dried grape skins from Amarone are added to the wine to give it more depth and body. This is a rich concentrated wine with raspberry, kirsch and cocoa notes.	
60. Shiraz, 'The Woodcutters', Torbreck - Barossa, Australia	£56
Full of deep, dark berry fruit, this Shiraz is one of the richest and most complex. A wonderful freshness and balance with an incredible deep central core of dark fruit giving way to an intense textural mid palate full of cassis, plum, spice and dark chocolate. (Ve)	
61. Château Grand Bert, St Emillion Grand Cru, France	£57
Velvety, structured, concentrated and powerful with a complex finesse. A beautiful cuvee of Cabernet Franc and Merlot aged 18 months in French oak barrels.	
62. Hochar Pere et Fils, Château Musar - Bekaa Valley, Lebanon	£61
Rich, spicy and aromatic, this robust red hails from a single Bekaa Valley vineyard planted with Cinsault, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan and Grenache over 40 years ago. Five years in the making, with 9 months in French oak barrels, it's full of smooth bramble fruit flavours, with hints of figs, dates and cedary.	
63. Sancerre Rouge, Domaine Berthier - Loire, France	£65
An enticingly aromatic and textured Pinot Noir displaying supple, medium-bodied raspberry and cherry notes, with a hint of dark pepper and soft, elegant tannins.	
64. Barolo, Casali del Barone - Piedmont, Italy	£72
A rich and full Barolo with notes of plum, red fruits, fruit compote, cedar, eucalyptus, tobacco and leather. All bolstered by firm but sweet tannins and silky texture, finishing with a toasted balsamic finish. (Ve)	
65. Grenache Shiraz Mataro 'The Steading', Torbreck -barossa, australia	£75
Deep ruby with flickers of violet, It's delicate aromas of truffle, five spice and spring flowers are supported by a rich core of liqourice, saddle leather and Provencal herbs. Very European in style, the palate is	

elegant and pure with subtle notes of crushed cherries, earth and cedar all neatly wound by a taut spine of acidity and ripe supple tannins. (Ve)

81. Château Haut Mouleyre (50cl) - Cadillac, France	£5	£30
A little gem from a slightly lesser known area of Bordeaux. The natural sweetness is enhanced by the 9 months it spends in oak prior to bottling.		
82. Grüner Veltliner Icewine (37.5cl) - Wagram, Austria	£8	£50
This Eiswein is made from grapes that have frozen on the vine, and thus yielding only the most concentrated nectar. The nose reveals tropical fruits of pineapple and passion fruit, before the palate broadens out to show honeycomb and apple pie. There is good refreshing acidity to always entice you in to another sip. (Ve)		
83. Pedro Ximénez Single Bota, Aged 5 years, Diatomists (37.5cl) - Jerez, Spain	£5	£35
The nose is packed with figs, dark chocolate, roasted coffee and cigar box aromas. Very smooth and balanced on the palate without cloying sweetness, this is an elegant PX aged for 5 years in bota. Extremely concentrated and nuanced, an ethereal wine with invigorating acidity. The finish is endless with a hint of nutmeg and cloves.		
84. White Heights Port, Cockburn's - Douro Portugal	£8	£45
Fresh tropical fruit flavours of papaya and pineapple with light aromas of honeysuckle. Crisp yellow plum and pear notes finish with just a touch of vanilla.		
85. Ruby Soho Port, Cockburn's - Douro Portugal	£8	£45
Bright aromas of blackberry fruit and toffee complement succulent red and black fruit flavours. Great freshness and balance are topped off with moments of explosive peppery spice.		
86. Tawny Eyes Port, Cockburn's - Douro Portugal	£8	£45
A fine textured port with generous aromas of honey, caramel, and a hint of vanilla. Subtle flavours of red fruit and walnuts make this an elegant and sensual wine.
